

More than **90%**

of the total waste collected for disposal in Singapore is incinerated



AND

less than **10%**

of it ends up in the landfill.



If this rate of waste continues **Singapore** would need to build one new incineration plant every 10 -15 years and one new landfill the size of **Sentosa** every 35 - 45 years!

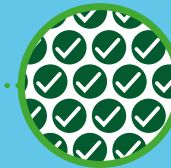
In 2014, AIG received the **Eco-Office Label** — the first and only insurer to obtain this highly regarded certification assessing an office's environmental performance.

By **2019**, all 5 AIG personal insurance products will be available online.



By **2020** we estimate that **half a million** personal insurance policies will be transacted electronically.



Half a million digital policies would save **2.5 million** sheets of paper a year and is equivalent to **300 trees.**
